TRANSPORT - NEW FOR 2023

Parents or guardians are responsible for transporting their child to and from the campsite this year. We recommend that children be accompanied by a responsible adult during transportation to ensure their safety. Any other time your child needs to travel to and from the camp site it will be on an official bus/coach or approved vehicle. It is important your children remain seated and belted at all times. This prevents drivers being distracted.

<u>Drop off time</u> on day of arrival – Staff will be on site from 3pm. Please do not bring your child before this time.

<u>Pick up time</u> – Please ensure you arrange for your child to be picked up no later than 11am.

Note: Parents <u>must</u> contact a Director in advance if they are arranging for someone other than the Parent/Guardian to be collecting their child.



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MOBILE PHONE POLICY NEW FOR 2023

Following a review of our Safeguarding Policy, we would strongly **discourage** you from sending a mobile phone with your child to the camp. However, if you choose to allow your child to bring their mobile phone, they <u>must</u> be handed in to a Director on arrival. We will be operating a lock box system where the phones will be stored and children will be given access to their phones at a designated time each day for one hour to contact their parents/guardians. This hour is for texting/calling home only. Children will be supervised during this time. <u>Use of social media and taking photos will not be permitted.</u> If children would like to take photos, we recommend they bring a disposable camera labelled with their name.

Camp Shamrock will not be responsible for any damage or loss of children's phones.

By limiting the use of mobile phones to a designated time only, we believe this encourages the children to interact more and feel that they will benefit fully from the experience of the camp. We ask that you please respect our decision and ask you to ensure your children cooperate accordingly.

In order to help us maintain our high standards, it is important that you read the Covid Management Information leaflet & Behaviour Policy and agree to the conditions on which you will be enrolling your child at Camp Shamrock.
